7. PLAY CLOSE

- a) For information – Contractor (Paul Rocker) on 28.11.17 repaired the dropped kerb around the toddler swing wet pour area.
- b) For information – the boundary wall has now been repaired by a contractor (Paul Rocker), on 16.1.18, organised by the Play Close Charity.

8. VILLAGE CENTRE SKATE PARK

For information - Area board approved funding to install a gate and additional fencing to the side of the skate park. This was fitted on 11.11.17 by a contractor (Steve Aplin).

9. VILLAGE CENTRE PLAY PARK

- a) For information – Contractor (Steve Aplin) on 11.11.17 repaired the damaged zip wire handle.
- b) For information - Damaged fencing reported on 31.10.17 has been repaired by Contractor (Steve Aplin) at the same time that the gate was fitted.
- c) The pedestrian entrance (up the slope) is very muddy, as is the entrance to the play park on that side. Council to consider if they would like to look at options for resurfacing these areas (we do have spare pea shingle and scalping's that could be utilised) - **ATTACHED**

10. JUNIOR FOOTBALL PITCH

- a) Council to consider what action they would like taken to improve the junior football pitch grass area. Areas are muddy especially around the goal mouths and need either reseeding, new turf, or other option. Groundstaff have found out about re-turfing costs from a previous supplier used Blackfords at Greenhill – **ATTACHED**
