

Bus Shelters

Purton Parish Council provides 7 bus shelters throughout the main bus route in Purton.(Purton Stoke, Packhorse junction, Station Road, High Street x 3, Highridge) These are maintained regularly, and this coming year will be painted and we are now looking at adding contact details, should there be any issues which residents can then call the office and report.

Flower Planters/Displays

The Parish Council provides the hanging baskets around the Village Hall and Institute Building and the planters situated throughout the village. If anyone would like to sponsor a planter please contact the offices.

Trees

Purton Parish Council has a large number of trees under their responsibility. These are assessed in line with Council policy every 3 years, by a certified arborist and we regularly carry out visual checks.

If a tree is causing concern and it is in a resident's property or business address and not Council owned, you can report to Wiltshire Council as a concern to public or highways safety. If you are unsure, please contact the office and we will advise.

Benches

Purton Parish Council maintains the benches in the recreation grounds, Cemetery and along Church path. The others are maintained by the organisations that donated them ie: twining/age concern etc.
